

Smoking on Board – Smoking Policy

The Siem group of companies is committed to apply all means under flag state regulations that promote the health of the employees.

Aligned with national regulations on smoking, therefore, the Siem smoking policy aims at protecting non smokers' rights to a work environment free of cigarette smoke.

Accordingly, smoking in the accommodation is strictly prohibited.

The following are the smoking restrictions applicable for all ships managed by Siem companies. The set of restrictions from item 1 – 4 in the below apply for electronic cigarettes as well as ordinary cigarettes.

1. While on board, smoking shall only be permitted in designed smoking areas, as specified by the Master.
2. Smoking is always prohibited where petroleum or gases may be encountered.
3. While alongside, even when no operations are in progress, smoking is only permitted in designated smoking areas, as instructed by Master.
4. Smoking on deck is prohibited while working alongside or inside the 500-meter zone of an offshore installation.
5. Disposal of cigarette butts must be into designated metal boxes only. The waste separation program will ensure that such boxes are emptied, and that the content is safely disposed of, either to the incinerator (if designed to burn plastics), or to be landed ashore.
